- Passed Higher Secondary School (10+2) or Diploma with 2 years or 3 Years Duration after 10th with science & biology (Min 45%)

## **The steps involved are:**

Step : 1. At the time admission Students need to Submit following original Certificates.

- 10th class Mark sheet & Passing Certificate
- 12th class Mark sheet & Passing Certificate (original)
- Address Proof ( Ration Card or Passport)
- School Leaving Certificate / Birth Certificate
- Cast Certificate & Cast Validity Certificate
- Latest 2 colored photograph (formal)

Student has to submit **2 sets** of attested photocopies of all above mentioned documents along with the

Admission application form. In case of reserve categories **5%** relaxation in HSC percentages will be given.

Will Hostel facilities are provided to outstation student?

Yes, a limited number of seats are available for girls at the Nerul Campus, Navi Mumbai on First-come-first serve basis. For boys, assistance in getting accommodation will be provided.

The 3- year full time program consists of six Semesters, each semester being of six month duration. The first semester mainly comprises of subjects related to general management, which would provide insights into managerial concepts. Here the focus is to give the students a firm grounding on the managerial skills and also in honing their interpersonal skills through a series of practical based sessions.

The School has been awarded the "Championship Trophy" in Entrepreneurship by the NEN- A Wadhvani Foundation. In the competition more than 400 colleges all over India participated and around 4.5 lakhs students participated. Students are encouraged to participate in community development program through SIP (Socially involved program) & SIFE (student in free enterprises-A Global Organization) projects. The Socially Involved Project Cell of the Department in association with SIFE (student in free enterprises) is involved in a women entrepreneurship project at VASAI -- near Vajreshwari -- to manufacture and market the food products like soya ladoos, methi ladoos etc. This project started a few months back and is being carried out in association with SIFE. Dr. Berry, Asst Prof. of Economics, Mount St. Mary's University, Maryland, US (member of global SIFE team) had visited the Department and addressed the departmental students.

- Do the professors have adequate work experience in industry and exposed to a competitive market environment?

The corporate experience of Professors at our Institute complements the teaching and research expertise. A majority of our professors include industry practitioners who have worked for private as well as public sector enterprises.

Deputation of the teachers to various seminars / conferences is a regular feature. Also, In-house faculty development programmes to enhance the working knowledge of the faculty are conducted on a regular basis. Some of these conducted recently are - 'How to write research paper' , 'Research Methodology, Data analysis, Case Study Writing, Business Communication, Public Speaking & Self awareness through Johari Windows.

The Department faculties participate in various extension activities. Faculty from the Departments under the faculty exchange program visited Swami Ramanand Teerth Marathwada University, Maharashtra, University of Calicut's, Naipunya Institute of Management and Technology, Kerala. Two members of faculty from Department have undergone faculty development programme in IIM, Bangluru and Stanford University, US. These initiatives of the Department help the faculty to improve their professional competency.

Two of our professors have been awarded the best Outstanding Researchers at the second Asia Pacific Marketing Conference held in Malaysia. Also, two of our professors have been recognized by the Stanford University as "Global Educator" in Entrepreneurship Management.

- Comment on the infrastructure of the Department. Some highlights of the infrastructure: Fully equipped classroom with LCD, OHP, Computers white boards, collar mike system and other state of art equipments.

Computer Lab: The air conditioned computer lab houses around 300 computer terminals with 24 hours Internet facility to help the students in developing their technical skills more productively. The students can also avail of database Packages like CMIE, SPSS, Pro-Quest & IBID. Computer lab timing for students (09.00am to 9.00pm).

Library: The library is well stocked with over 8000 titles and 29 national and 25 international journals. Also there are 360 educational CDs, 11 periodicals and magazines which cater to the needs of the students as well as the faculties. Around 15,000 e-journals through Pro-Quest are also available. Library timing for the students (09.00am to 9.00pm including Sundays)

Auditorium: The University campus at Nerul also has 750-seater auditorium with state of art equipment.

Cafeteria: DYPUSM offers hygienic snacks and food for the students, faculty & staff.

Sports facilities: The sprawling University campus at Nerul houses a Rs. 200 Crore stadium with state of art facilities and a seating capacity of more then 50000 persons. For indoor activities special rooms are available for carom chess badminton etc.

- Does the school offer research facilities?

Yes. Our Research & Extension Centre handles the M.Phil and the Ph.D. programs Management Research, Management Development Programs (MDP's) & Extension Activities. The Research and Extension Centre publishes the annual Research Journal called "DYPUSM Research Review"- a compendium of research papers written by well known Management Gurus all over the world.

Faculty and students are encouraged to publish Research Papers in in-house as well as outside research Journals. A majority of these have been published in journals of reputed institutes like IIT's & IIM's. The DYPUSM has published the following Journals / Newsletters:
